Course Objectives	When commuting with your superior or a stranger, or when transmitting information to many unspecified persons, it is important to use polite expressions and accurately convey the information. Students in this class will learn Japanese expressions used in formal situations, how to write everyday and practical sentences, and skills for oral presentation in Japanese.
Course Goals	(1) Be able to choose appropriate terms and expressions according to the situation. (2) Be able to convey necessary information to listeners and readers so that it is easily understood. (3) Acquire basic presentation skills.
Class schedule	Week 1 - Week 5: Review of polite expressions, including honorific words Week 6 - Week 7: Greetings, and speaking on the phone Week 8 - Week 9: How to write a letter, e-mail, etc. Week 10 - Week 11: Honorific words used in business documents Week 12: Review, check test Week 13: Feedback for check test, preparing a manuscript for presentation Week 14: Preparing presentation slides Week 15: How to make an oral presentation, how to give an opinion/comment
