Course Objectives	Students in this class will learn new kanji to increase the vocabulary, while organizing the kanji knowledge previously learnt. They will understand the meanings of kanji and vocabulary words required for study and research life at university and for daily life, and will acquire ability to correctly read, write, and use them. This class will also support students to develop their own kanji learning strategies through class activities.
Course Goals	Learn the basic kanji and vocabulary commonly used in a variety of professional fields. Be able to correctly use the kanji and vocabulary words, not only reading and writing them.
