Course Objectives	Students in this class will learn logical development methods, constructions, expressions, by examining actual reports and paper, to acquire basic skills to write logical sentences. They will also learn the rules for preparing a report. In the middle of the semester, they will begin writing a report with a theme of their choice, and will submit the report on the final day.
Course Goals	Gain the knowledge of constructions, grammar, and expressions required for writing logical sentences, and be able to write a report in Japanese.
