Course Objectives	Students in this class will construct a story in Japanese on their own about a specified topic, aiming to acquire the intermediate Japanese language skills required for university and daily life.
Course Goals	Be able to tell a story in a well-structured and easy-to-understand way, using appropriate discourse organization, grammar and vocabulary, about topics talked about in university and daily life. Develop ability to understand a variety of information, including situations in Japan. For these, acquire the knowledge of beginner/intermediate grammar, the ability to use it, and rich vocabulary.
