Course Objectives	The aim of this class is to provide students with basic knowledge necessary for learning kanji, such as origins, radicals, and word structure, and to learn the meaning and usage of basic kanji and kanji vocabulary. This class also aims to support students acquire learning strategies suitable for themselves and lead to autonomous learning.
Course Goals	Students will be able to: 1. obtain basic knowledge about Kanji learning in a systematic way. 2. read and write and understand the meaning of basic kanji vocabulary necessary for daily life. 3. learn how to remember, recall, and organize the kanji they have learned so that they can use them as needed.
