Course Objectives	In this course, students will focus on developing basic speaking and listening skills at the beginner level and acquire conversational abilities that can be immediately used in everyday situations and university life. The course also aims to help students learn fundamental grammar and vocabulary needed at the introductory stage of Japanese, as well as to recognize hiragana and katakana. In addition, comprehensive practice is provided to develop all four language skills—listening, speaking, reading, and writing—so that students can respond to a variety of communicative activities.
